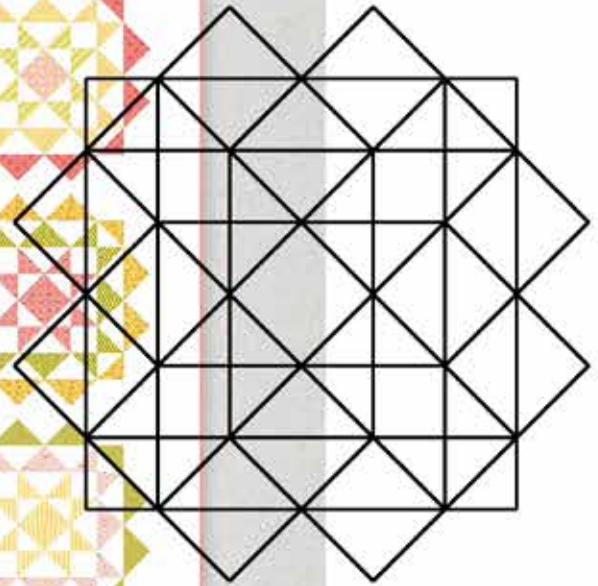
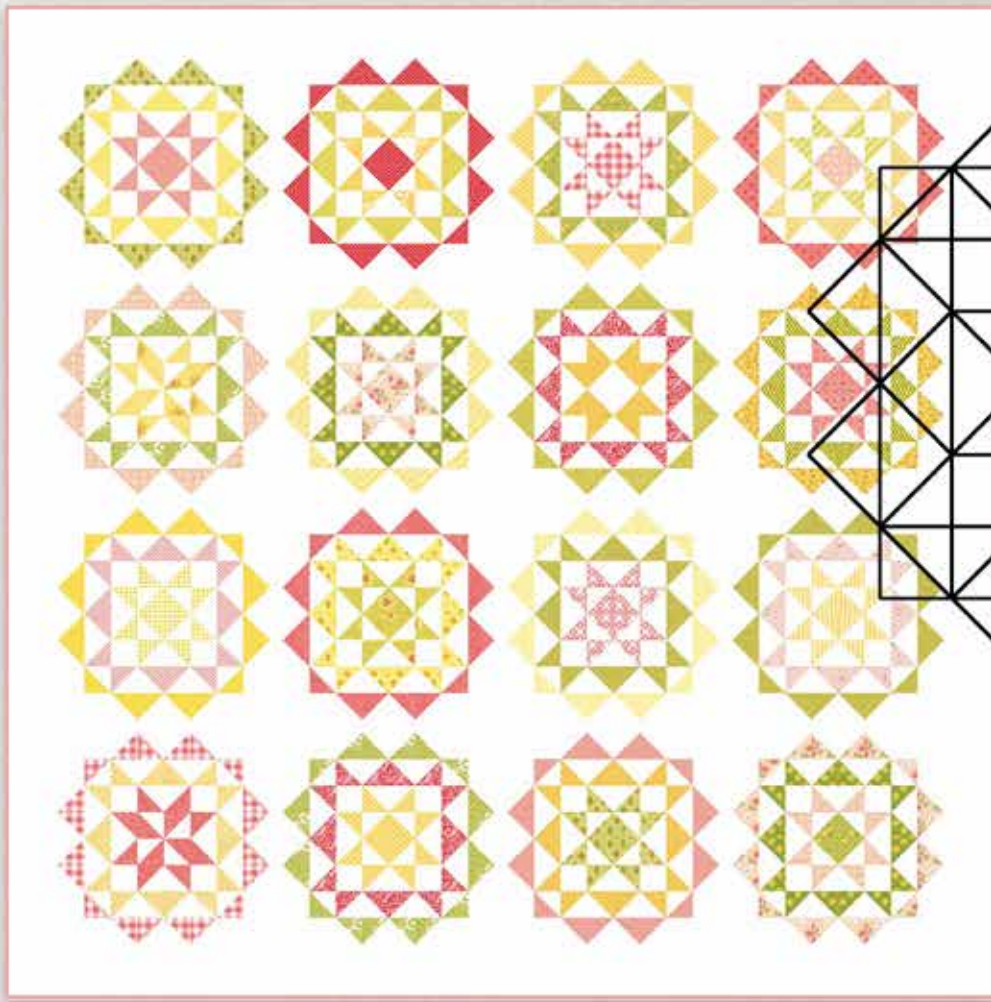
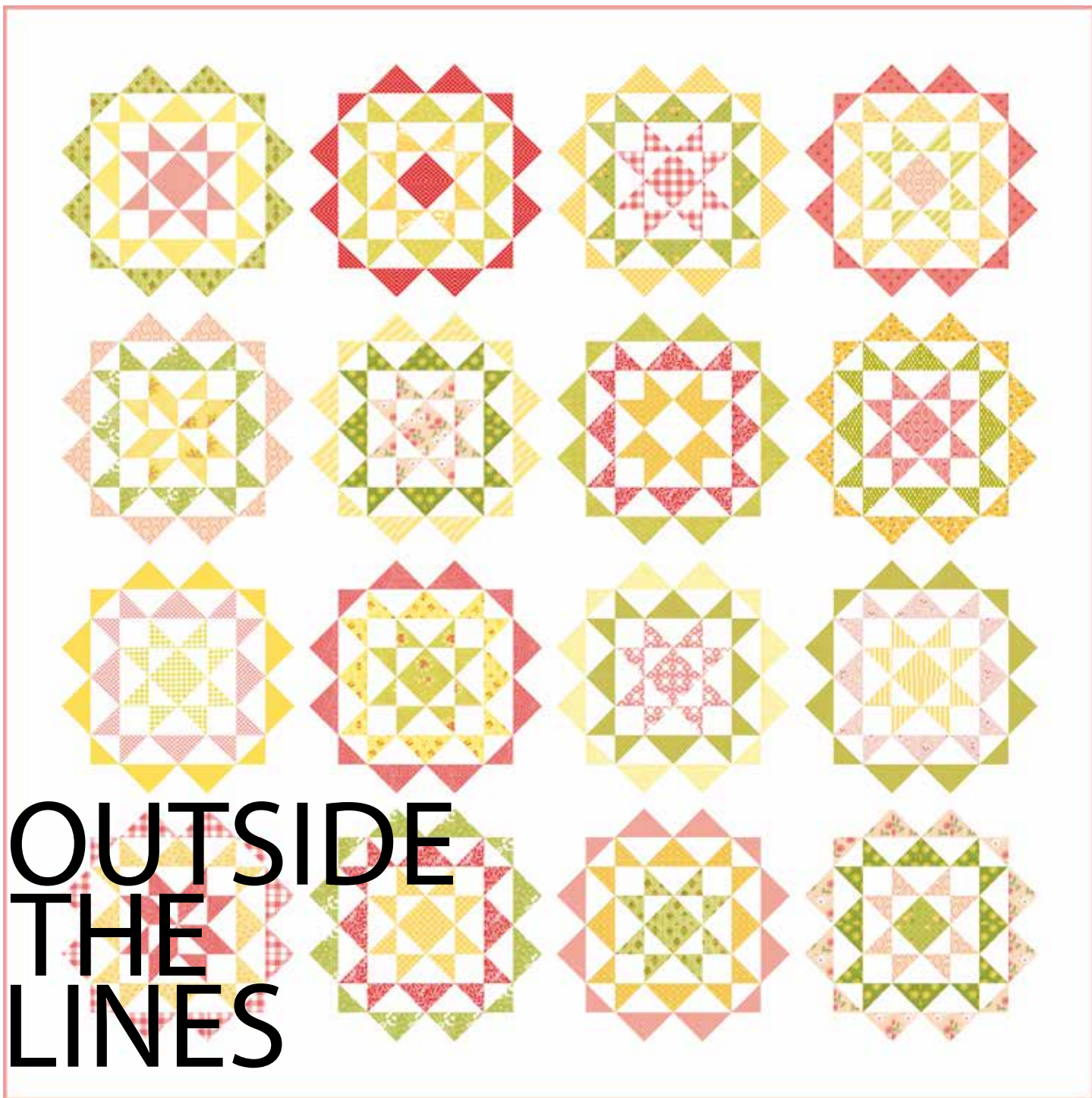

Bella Solid 9900-98 for Moda

This pattern is designed to use Cake Mix Papers, Stock # CM3 and Moda layer cakes to make all the triangles. Ask for these items at your favorite quilt or specialty fabric store.

FINISHED SIZE: 75" X 75"

NOTE: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise stated. Please read carefully through all instructions before you get started.

MATERIALS LIST

All fabrics are from 44" wide quilt-weight
 For the quilt top
 1 pad Cake Mix Recipe #3 (CM3)
 3 Junior Layer Cakes™ of prints
 1 Layer Cake™ Bella Solid White (9900LC-98)
 3 yards of Bella Solid White (9900-98)

For the backing 4 3/4 yards
 For the binding 5/8 yard

79" x 79" piece of batting (80% cotton, 20% poly)

1. CUTTING THE FABRICS

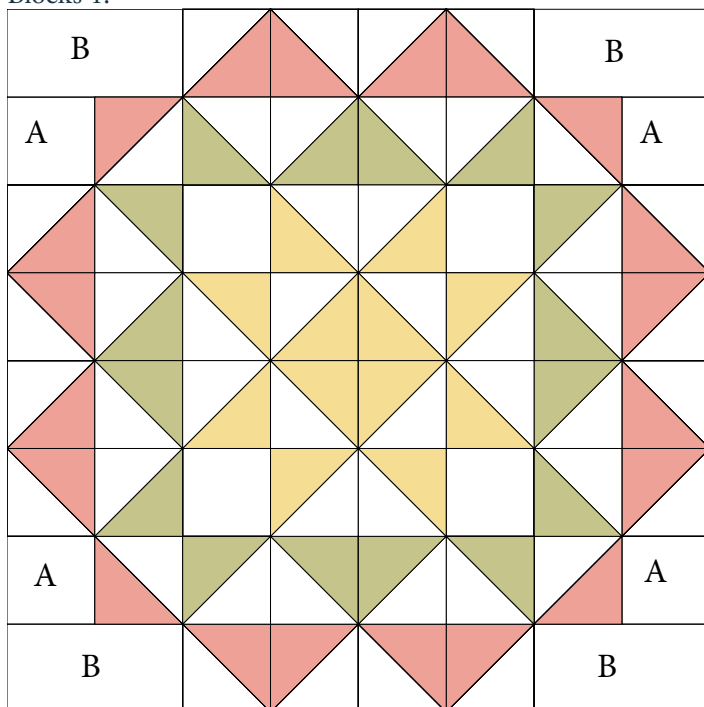
From the Bella Solid White yardage, cut
 2 longer border strips, each 75 1/2" x 4 1/2"
 2 shorter border strips, each 67 1/2" x 4 1/2"
 3 horizontal sashing strips, each 67 1/2" x 1 1/2"
 2 squares 10" x 10" (add those to your white Layer Cake stack)
 12 vertical sashing strips, each 16 1/2" x 1 1/2"
 64 rectangles 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" (B)
 64 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (A)

2. ASSEMBLE THE BLOCKS

Cake Mix Recipe #3 includes 44 recipe cards. One assembled Recipe Card yield eighteen 2" finished half square triangles. Sew half square triangles from the complete three Junior Layer Cakes of prints and white background fabric following the instructions given by the Recipe Cards. Quilt shown used 16 pinks, 14, greens and 14 yellows, pair up sets and colors accordingly.

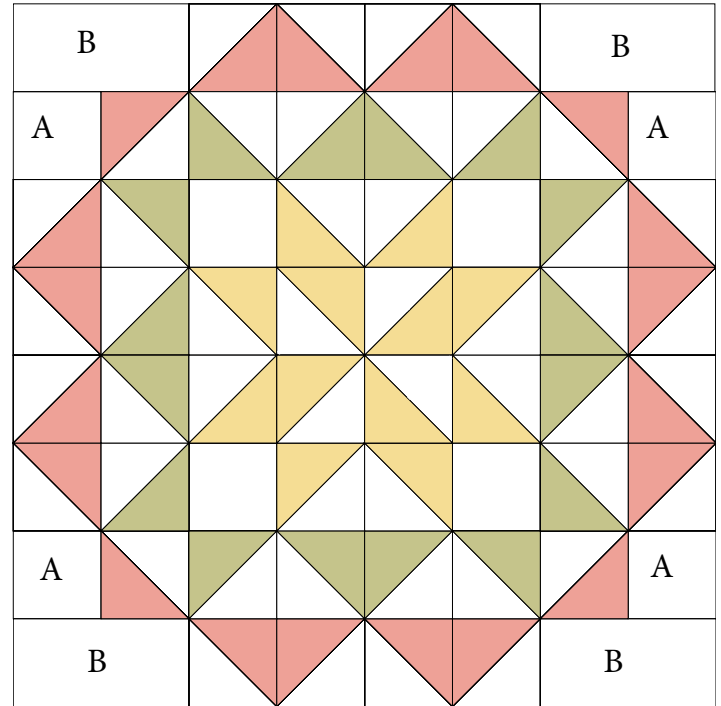
BLOCK 1

Following the Quilt Assembly diagram make a total of 13 Blocks 1.



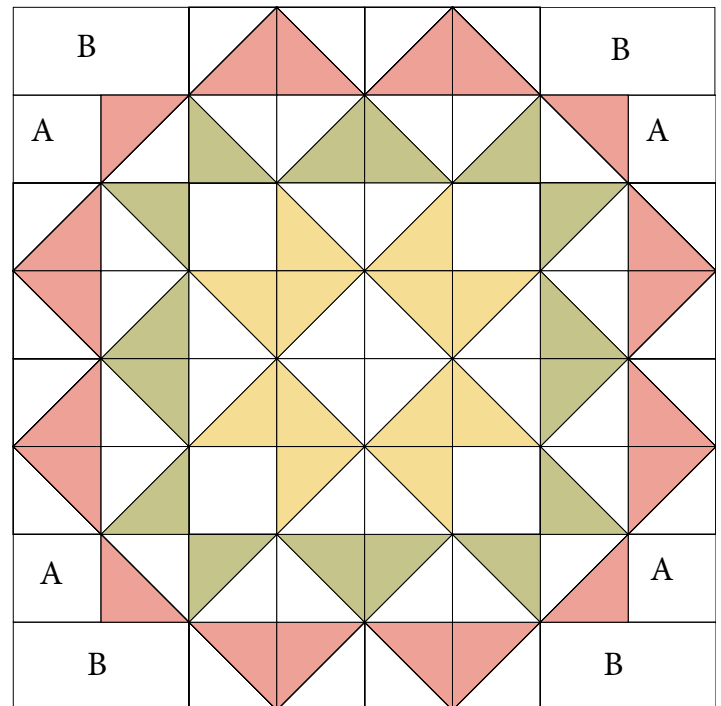
BLOCK 2

Following the Quilt Assembly diagram make a total of 2 Blocks 2.



BLOCK 3

Following the Quilt Assembly diagram make one Block 3



Each block should measure 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" including seam allowances.

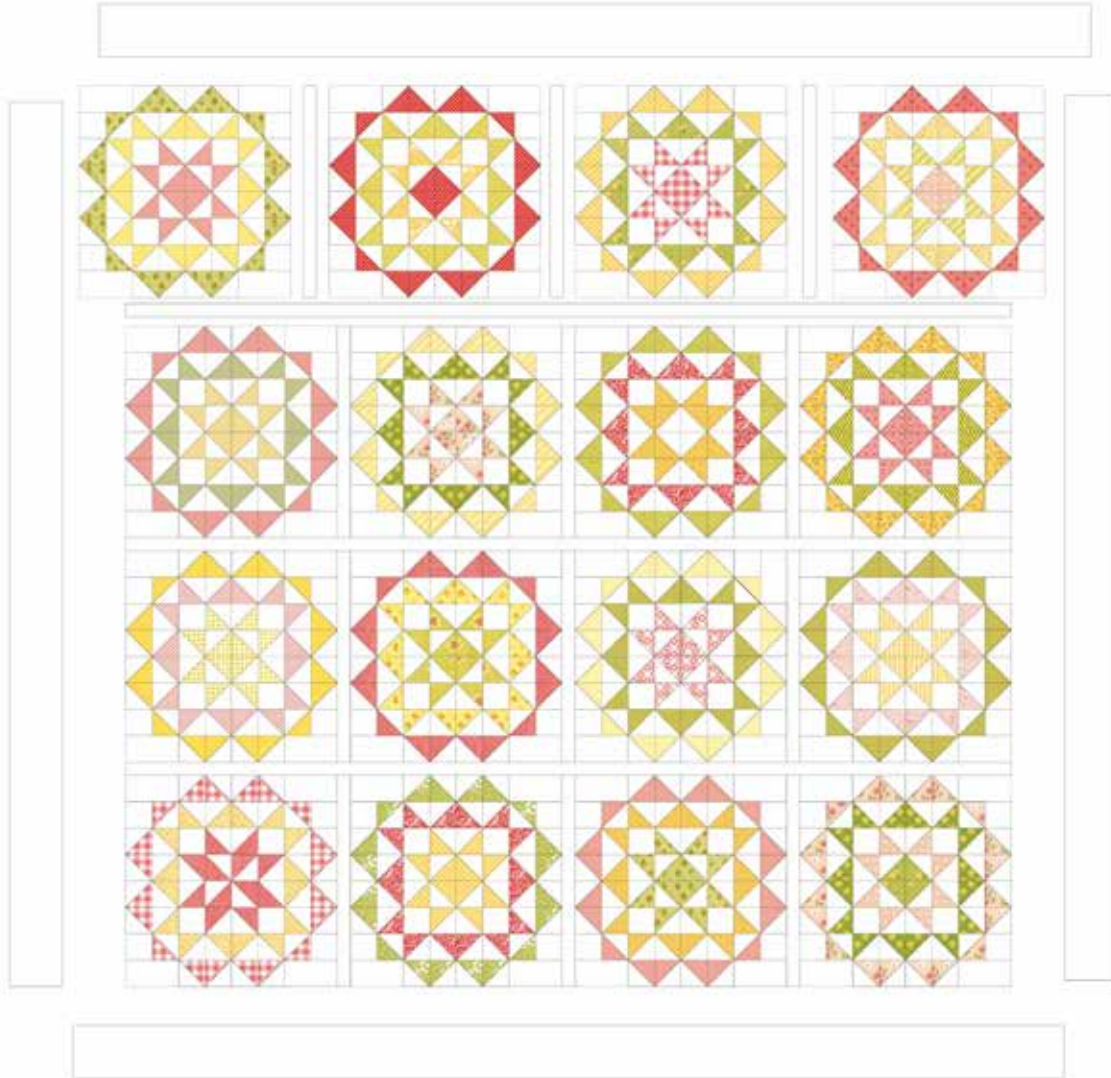
3. ASSEMBLE THE QUILT CENTER

Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out pieced blocks and sashing rectangles in 7 vertical rows. Sew together pieces in each row. Each pieced row should be $67\frac{1}{2}'' \times 16\frac{1}{2}''$ including seam allowances.

Join pieced block rows and horizontal sashing rows to make quilt center. Press seams towards sashing strips. The quilt center should be $67\frac{1}{2}'' \times 67\frac{1}{2}''$ including seam allowances.

4. ADD BORDERS

Add shorter border strips to the left and right side of quilt center. Add longer border strips to top and bottom.



Build quilt-sandwich, quilt and bind.
